How does it work?

We want to involve your group in missions! Churches, individuals, and other groups host a shoe drive to collect gently used or new shoes of all types and sizes - sandals, boots, sneakers, or dress shoes. The shoes are exported to developing nations, such as Kenya and Haiti, where demand for used shoes is strong. The funds generated from exporting are then used by Harvesters to support the vital work of our ministry partners around the world.

How are the funds spent?

That's one of the exciting things about Shoes 4 Hope! Your group will select a project or ministry that is dear to your heart. We have ministry partners in Africa, Asia, and Russia. Their outreach includes orphan care, education, medical care, women's empowerment, evangelism, clean drinking water, and much more. We will help you find the right fit for your group!

How do we host a shoe drive?

Hosting a shoe drive is easy! Shoes 4 Hope provides the collection boxes, storage bags, and promotional materials needed for a successful drive. We will coordinate with your group to arrange pick up of the shoes you gather. Many groups request a \$0.25 per pair contribution to help cover the cost of handling the shoes. This voluntary contribution increases the funding available for our missions projects.
